3. Photos are welcome as part of articles and announcements. Please send as scanned files. For music, send lyrics, scanned sheet music or sound files. For art, send as bitmap or gif files. Send text as a word processing file or as a pdf. Texts which contain Hebrew and/or graphics must be sent as pdf or related type file.
4. To keep our site "reader friendly," please keep paragraphs short.
5. Submit material you are comfortable sharing with the public.
6. If you have material you would like to post in our password protected section for members only, please contact Rabbi Harry Zeitlin for details.
7. To include a piece of your writing which is on another website, please send an abstract, summary or blurb and a link and we will post both. We prefer not to post pieces in their entirety which are available elsewhere on the web.
8. All submissions must comport with the ALEPH Eighteen Principles and OHALAH's Mission Statement and are subject to approve by Rabbi Harry Zeitlin
